Volunteer Opportunities

The Community Pregnancy Clinic (CPC) is a licensed medical clinic dedicated to helping women and families in unplanned pregnancies. We are pro-life and our mission is to protect, preserve and promote life. This occurs by empowering women through education and information to help her make the best decision for her physical, mental, and spiritual health. Our free services include ultrasound exams, pregnancy tests, STD/STI tests, post-abortion recovery, and sexual abuse recovery.

Volunteers are the lifeblood of our ministry. We can't function without them! Whether you volunteer as a nurse, receptionist, or clinic cleaner - all of our volunteers have a direct impact on saving lives in and around our community.

Volunteering in the Simi Clinic

The CPC has been located in Simi Valley to serve our community since 1990. Currently the clinic is open Monday - Thursday (ranging from noon to about 6pm) and volunteer shifts are on average 3 hours a week.

Simi Valley Clinic volunteer opportunities include:

- Client Advocate: Listen, educate, and provide a source of physical, emotional, and spiritual hope to women and families through one on one compassionate care. (Training Course provided)
- Nurse: Administer pregnancy tests and ultrasound exams. Must be a Registered Nurse. (Females only) LOUS training required/provided.
- Receptionist: As the first impression, make the client feel safe and confident that they are in good hands. Answer phones, direct calls accordingly, and occasionally help with office projects. (Females only)
- General office: Assist with filing, typing, letter writing. Cleaning the clinic once a week, or keeping our client supply closet in good order.

Volunteering in the Mobile Clinic

The heart behind the Mobile Clinic is to bring much needed resources to under-served neighboring communities, bringing hope to a seemingly hopeless place. The CPC began serving the inner-city of Los Angeles in 2009 and is now a well-known, trusted resource in Watts (the projects) traveling to Los Angeles Wednesdays and Fridays. Volunteers serving in Los Angeles leave Simi Valley at 9am and return at approx. 5pm.

Mobile Clinic volunteer opportunities include:

Mobile Driver: Drive mobile clinic to location, set-up, greet and check in clients. Acts as discrete security. No special class license required. Must have experience driving an RV, a good driving record and proof of insurance. (Males only)

Other Volunteering in and around CPC

Not all of our volunteer roles are on a weekly basis or directly inside the clinic walls. The following is not an exhaustive list, so if you have a skill set you think may benefit the CPC, please contact us! A few examples of other volunteer roles include:

Hotliner: Ensure clients in need can reach us at anytime by receiving forwarded client calls to your cell phone when the clinic is closed. (Females only)

Special Events: Be on call to help with special events like the Annual Banquet, Simi Valley Street Fair, Worship 4 Life and more by joining our volunteer emailing list.

Other Support: Graphic design, tech support, handyman, single-mom support, clinic cleaner, and more!

Group Volunteering: We occasionally need the help of the masses. It may be flyering, cleaning the clinic or mobile clinic, or hosting a diaper drive. Let us know if you have a group that would like to be contacted when a need like this arises.
