For over twenty-five years, Children's Hunger Fund (CHF) has partnered with local churches in 24 countries to provide food and the hope of the gospel to children and families living in extreme poverty.

Since 1991, Children's Hunger Fund (CHF) has come alongside the local church in the US and around the globe to deliver life-saving food and aid with a message of hope that is eternal. At the heart of CHF is the Food Pak, a box that holds up to 20 pounds of nutritious food. From distribution centers located in San Antonio, Dallas, and the Los Angeles headquarters, Food Paks are distributed to CHF Mercy Network churches in 24 countries who then deliver them directly to the homes of families living in extreme poverty.
