Day 1 Questions

How did God help Dominique do the hard things we saw in the video?

Is there something you'd like to try but haven't because it seems too hard? Think about it for a minute and share a personal example

Find and Read today's Bible Verse: Philippians 4:13 says, "For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength."

Jesus' power helps us do hard things. (Trust Jesus!)

Prayer: Dear Lord, we believe your promises, and we believe we can do everything through Christ, who gives us strength. Thank you! In Jesus' name, amen.

Day 2 Questions

Who in your life brings you comfort at home? What do they do? What talent do you have-something you're good at- that could bring comfort and hope to someone?

Find and Read today's Bible Verse: Psalm 31:24, "So be strong and courageous, all you who put your hope in the Lord."

What do you think it means to put your hope in the Lord?

When is a time you need to put your hope in the Lord-a time you need Jesus to give you strength and courage? Share a personal example of a time you need Jesus to give you strength and courage.

Jesus' power gives us hope! (Trust Jesus!)

Prayer: Dear Lord, please give us the strength and courage to bring hope to others. And thank you for letting us put our hope in you. Thank you for always loving us. Thank you for giving us hope when we need it. Please help us always put our hope in you. In Jesus' name, amen.

Day 3 Questions

What would be great about serving in a community kitchen? Have you ever wanted to help someone, but something kept you from doing it?

Find and Read today's Bible Verse: Isaiah 40:29, "He gives power to the weak and strength to the powerless."

Think of a way you could boldly serve Jesus and help others. Remember, think bold!

Prayer: Dear Lord, please give us power and strength to serve and show our faith in you. Thank you for helping us boldly live out our faith. We love you. In Jesus' name, amen.

Day 4 Questions

What does the word **forever** mean to you?

Because of Jesus, Joel (Issac's brother) is living with Jesus right now! And we can do the same someday! It's okay to be sad when someone dies, but it's so great that the sadness won't last forever. And life with Jesus will last forever!

What do you think heaven will be like?

Day 5 Questions

Find and Read today's Bible Verse: John 15:12, "My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you."

What's a hard thing you could help a friend with?

How could you give a friend hope? What could you do?

How could you help a friend be bold?

Prayer: Dear Lord, your power and your love are amazing! Thank you for being the best friend we'll ever have, and thank you for showing us how to be good friends. Please be with each of us as we go out into the world to live for you. Thank you for loving us. In Jesus' name, amen.
