We find God to the degree we want to find him. Until our passion for finding God exceeds all other passions, and until we long to know him as our Lord and friend more than to use him to get what we want (the way a spoiled child uses a rich father), we will not find him as deeply as he longs to be found. ... God wants to let us find him. ... God delights to be discovered. He is not playing hard to get. Something about the way we are and who he is makes it necessary for us to want him more than we want anyone or anything else before we can find him. "You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. I will be found by you." (Jeremiah 29:13-14). (Larry Crabb, Finding God)
