1) _____

Continuous attitude; opposed to judgement and reason

2) _____

3) _____

Desire to cause pain to another

4) _____

Desire to hurt or defame another through words

5) _____

Obscene, crude, abusive talk

For the mouth speaks what the heart is full of. (Matthew 12:34)
