⇒ *Our Story: The Tale of Two Men (Romans 5)*

Romans 5:12-21/1 Corinthians 15:45

Just as one trespass resulted in condemnation for all people, so also one righteous act resulted in justification and life for all people. For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous. (Romans 5:18-19)

⇒ *The Problem with The Law (Romans 7)*

I found that the very commandment that was intended to bring life actually brought death. For sin, seizing the opportunity afforded by the commandment, deceived me, and through the commandment put me to death. (Romans 7:10-11)

Through the law I died to the law so that I might live for God. (Galatians 2:19)

⇒ *Out of Adam ... Into Christ (Romans 6)*

Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. (Romans 6:3-4)

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
